

Erasmus + (2014 - 2020)





- Transnational **cooperation** projects, based on multilateral partnerships between HEI's in Programme and Partner Countries. It aims to **support**, **contribute** and **promote** the **development** of the **Partner Countries HEI's**.
- 2 possible categories of CB's:
 - Joint Projects: outcomes benefit principally/directly Partner Countries org. – curriculum development, HEI's management and governance modernisation (...)
 - **Structural Projects:** impact on HE systems and promote reforms at national/regional level. Must involve as parterns Ministries for higher education in Partner Countries.
- Projects must adress the Regional and Cross-Cuting Priorities, defined annualy by the EACEA, to the different 10 Regions (total 14 Regions).
