Admission Requirements for International Students

- Foreign students other than EU Member States.
- Students that, when not nationals of a Member State of the EU, do not reside legally in Portugal for more than two years uninterruptedly.
- Students who hold a diploma of completion of secondary education (high school) or equivalent in their home country.

When an applicant has two or more citizenships and one of them corresponds to an European Union Member State, including Portugal, he or she cannot apply for International Student vacancies, but he or she must apply for EU/National vacancies.

Students who don't fulfill the requeriments for International Student should contact the Admissions Office as soon as possible.

Required Documents

Applications for a specific course/degree or study cycle programme are made online. The applicant must provide all the documents mentioned in the Regulation, as well as a motivation letter referring to the selected course or study cycle. To complete the application process it is necessary to submit the following scanned documents as PDF files:

- Recent photo
- ■Up-to-date CV
- Official academic transcript proving that you have completed secondary (high school) education or equivalent in the country of origin and proof of access to higher education examinations (this applies only to the applicant's to 1st study cycle)
- Official academic transcript of records of Bachelor degree and Diploma (this applies only to the applicant's to 2nd study cycle)
- Document specifying the type of grading scheme used on the academic records.
- Document certifying the applicant's Portuguese language level (this applies only to the 1st study cycle).
- Statement under oath, that the applicant does not have portuguese nationality nor any other country nationality that is member of the EU and fulfills the requirements needed for the Access and Admission category for International Students.
- Bank transfer slip of the payment for the application fee.
- Display of the identification document(passport, foreign citizen card or other appropriate), or, when authorized by the applicant, a simple photocopy of the identification document.

Applicants should refer to the IST Regulations for Admission of International Students of 1st, 2nd, 3rd cycle for further information related to documents and validation.
