Admission Requirements for International Students

- Foreign students other than EU Member States.
- Students that, when not nationals of a Member State of the EU, do not reside legally in Portugal for more than two years uninterruptedly.
- Students who hold a diploma of completion of secondary education (high school) or equivalent in their home country.

When an applicant has two or more citizenships and one of them corresponds to an European Union Member State, including Portugal, he or she cannot apply for International Student vacancies, but he or she must apply for EU/National vacancies.

Students who don't fulfill the requirements for International Student should contact the Admissions Office as soon as possible.



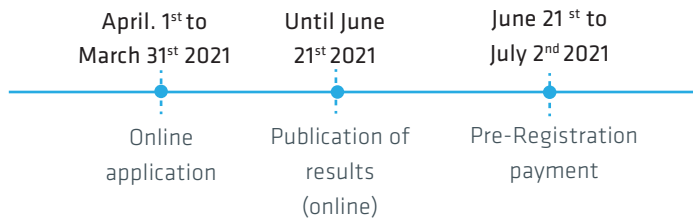
Applications 1st, 2nd and 3rd cycles

All selection, registration and enrollment processes must be concluded by September 30th.

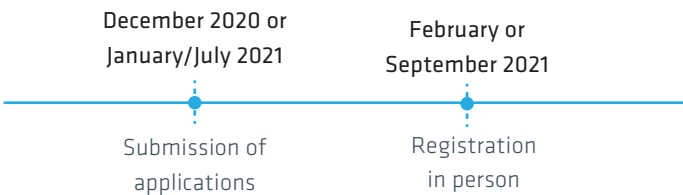
1st Round/Call - 1st cycle Bachelor and 2nd Cycle Master

Accommodation (room) - 375-550€ per month

Accommodation (flats) - 550-900€ per month

Accommodation* - 180€ per month

Meals - +/- 200€ per month (student residency)

Bus, metro/train pass - 30€ per month

Cinema - 7€

Museums - 2-15€

*up to 10 places - After payment of the pre-enrollment fee, an e-mail is sent to find out the student's interest in accommodation in the residence. Vacancies are allocated to candidates in the 1st phase and according to the best average grade. Deposit value of approx. 250 euros. Amount may change, contact Accommodation Office



Required Documents

Applications for a specific course/degree or study cycle programme are made online. The applicant must provide all the documents mentioned in the Regulation, as well as a motivation letter referring to the selected course or study cycle. To complete the application process it is necessary to submit the following scanned documents as PDF files:

- Recent photo
- Up-to-date CV
- Official academic transcript proving that you have completed secondary (high school) education or equivalent in the country of origin and proof of access to higher education examinations (this applies only to the applicant's to 1st study cycle)
- Official academic transcript of records of Bachelor degree and Diploma (this applies only to the applicant's to 2nd study cycle)
- Document specifying the type of grading scheme used on the academic records.
- Identification document / passport
- Document certifying the applicant's Portuguese language level (this applies only to the 1st study cycle).
- Statement under oath, that the applicant does not have Portuguese nationality nor any other country nationality that is member of the EU and fulfills the requirements needed for the Access and Admission category for International Students.
- Bank transfer slip of the payment for the application fee.

Tuition Fees

1st and 2nd cycle: 7.000 € / year

- 2.000 € paid upon pre-registration
- 1.000 € x 5 months (September 2020 until May 2021) paid monthly

3rd cycle: 2.750 € / year

- 50% paid upon enrolment
- 50% until the end of Feb. or Aug.

Application fee: 100 € (BSc)
100 € per degree (MSc)
